



# BERLIN HIGH SCHOOL TRAP SHOOTING

## “B” LETTER REQUIREMENTS

- You must be in good academic standing -no failing grades.
- You must follow the BHS Code of Conduct.
- You must fully participate in & complete the Central Wisconsin Youth Trap League (CWYTL)
- You may either fully participate in & complete the Kettle Moraine Conference (KMC) or participate in the Berlin Target Terminator (BTT) program, shooting at least half of the scheduled shoots.
- You must attend at least ten scheduled practices.
- You must shoot at two events which are held at other venues, not at the BCC.
- You must volunteer at a major one or two day event held at the BCC.
- You must have accumulated a total of eighty (80) points in the school year to earn a letter. The school year is June 1<sup>st</sup> of the previous school year to May 31<sup>st</sup> of you current school year.

The opportunity to participate in extracurricular activities is extended to all students as a privilege to all who are willing to assume certain responsibilities. You will be expected to display high standards of behavior, good sportsmanship, and respect for others, observe all school rules, and meet established eligibility requirements. You are not to possess or consume any alcohol, tobacco of any kind, or illegal drugs at any time. Trap shooting is not a WIAA affiliated sport, however, you are expected to follow all rules currently in place in the BHS Extracurricular Handbook. The Code of Conduct will be enforced throughout the entire calendar year.

Coaches have the right to enforce the BHS Extracurricular Handbook. Any infractions or issues will be decided by the coaches. Penalties may include removal from the program or loss of points earned toward your letter.



## **CENTRAL WISCONSIN YOUTH TRAP LEAGUE (CWYTL)**

CWYTL is an 8 week league held at the Berlin Conservation Club on Saturday mornings beginning the first Saturday of March of each year. Any school aged student, through grade 12, can participate in this league, but they must have successfully completed a hunter's education course. All shooters must be enrolled in school, attending in a regular basis, and be compliant with their school's code of conduct and academic requirements.

Completing the CWYTL is a requirement towards earning a letter in trap shooting.

## **KETTLE MORAINÉ CONFERENCE (KMC)**

This conference was formed in 2011 with six teams and 160 athletes. Since then, the conference has grown to 19 teams and over 800 athletes. The conference was split into two divisions - North and South - in 2014. The KMC consists of nine dual meets for each team in which athletes shoot 50 targets. The conference ends with a 100 target conference shoot at the WTA home grounds in Rome, WI. This is a high school conference, but middle school athletes may still participate though their scores do not count for the conference standings.

Our team from Berlin has combined with Ripon High School athletes to make up one team and are in the North Division. Other North Division schools are Central Wisconsin Christian (Waupun), Fond du Lac, North Fond du Lac, Oakfield, Twin City (Neenah), Waupaca Comets, Wautoma, Winneconne Wolves. South Division schools are Beaver Dam, Campbellsport, Daniel Boone Conservation League (Hubertus), Flyway Clay Slayers (Lomira), Hartford Conservation & Gun Club, Horicon Youth Trap Team, Kewaskum, Ozaukee and West Bend.

Completing KMC is a requirement towards earning a letter in trap shooting.

## **BERLIN TARGET TERMINATORS (BTT)**

The Berlin Target Terminators is a youth traveling trap shooting team that is sponsored by the Berlin Conservation Club. This Club travels around the state and competes in different trap shooting competitions. Practice and various shoots typically starts in April. The season ends at the beginning of August at the AIM Nationals in Sparta, IL.

Most recently, Berlin has had 3 State Champions, Steven Klika, Jackson Davey, and Alex Konen (2015 BHS graduate). They competed against other state champions from all over the country in what is called "The Champion of Champions" in Sparta, IL.

If you choose not to participate in KMC, you must shoot in a minimum of half of the BTT shooting events to earn points towards a letter in trap shooting.
